On the course, only evidence of the masses remained. Carts zipped across the well-manicured fairways, toting garbage off the property. Remnants of walking paths scarred the green grass, created by the hordes of people who hoped to catch a glimpse of the newest major champion.

For the first time in a week, however, a peaceful silence fell upon the grounds at Southern Hills Country Club, and all of Tulsa breathed a sigh of relief, knowing they had just shown their best side to the entire golf world.

SETTING RECORDS

The PGA Championship returned to Tulsa, Oklahoma for a record fifth time in May of 2022. Nearly 300,000 people attended the championship at Southern Hills, a historic 1935 Perry Maxwell-designed golf course that was renovated by Gil Hanse in 2018.

And while the on-course successes are well documented, what isn't as well known is the club hosted the championship in short time. When the PGA of America announced its move away from the championship's originally announced location, the club had less than two years to prepare for the event. What ensued was a textbook display of public/private partnerships to pull off the most anticipated sporting event in Tulsa's history. As a result, the City of Tulsa estimates the championship had an impact of more than \$140 million on the local economy.

Not bad for the gem of Green Country.
